### From the Desk of the Lay Director

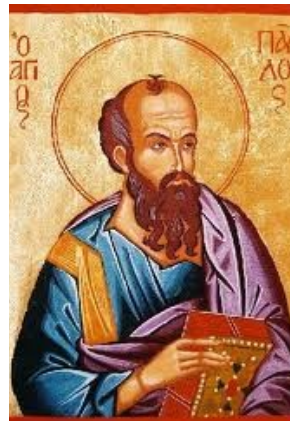

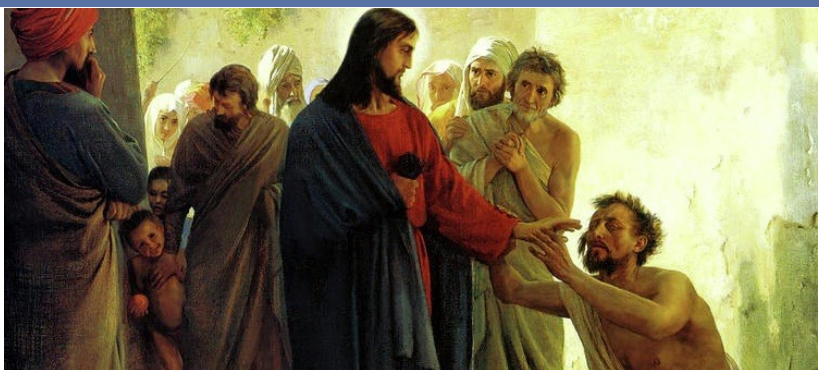
