The Simple Prayer of Spiritual Adoption

Such a simple little prayer; it takes only seconds to say, but this prayer means a lifetime to one of God's most precious gifts, the beautiful and vulnerable unborn. "This short prayer was first written by Archbishop Fulton Sheen in 1973 after the US Supreme Court legalized abortion. Invoking the intercession of the Holy Family; he pleaded for divine protection over unborn babies in danger of abortion."

"Jesus, Mary and Joseph, I love you very much. I beg you to spare the of the life unborn child that I have spiritually adopted who is in danger of abortion."

Archbishop Sheen encouraged Catholics to pray this simple prayer daily for nine months in the name of the baby they have spiritually adopted. He believed that by such "spiritual adoption of the unborn, one prayer at a time, the advance of the culture of death in America would be thwarted."

Spiritual adoption is an act of compassion which comes from a pure heart and generosity of spirit of one individual to another through prayers and blessings.

Today the act of spiritual adoption continues as Archbishop Sheen's prayer is circulated around the world; thanks to the efforts of a Colorado man Arthur Maes who has distributed more than ten million prayer cards through his organization Crusade for Life International.

"Only through prayer will we have peace in this world," Maes said" you can't kill a million and a half babies a year and not end up facing the wrath of God." Maes wanted all Christians to use the power of prayer to stop what Saint Teresa of Calcutta called "the most grievous sin in the world." Here is how spiritual adoption works: people across the country participate in this apostolate by praying the short Bishop Sheen prayer for nine months. Anyone can participate in spiritual adoption, there are no strings attached. This apostolate is an act of unconditional love and compassion, and no act of compassion, no matter how large or small, is ever wasted. Saying this prayer for the unborn will promote a culture of life.

The back of the card reads: "during your earthly life, this spiritually adopted child of yours will be known only to God, but in the world to come it is hoped that you will meet the child whose life was spared by your prayers and spend eternal happiness with them."

Such a simple yet powerful prayer. Will you participate in this act of unconditional love and pray for the unborn?
