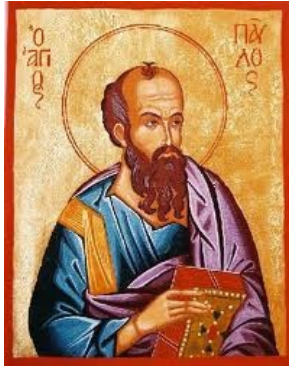

# SCHOOL OF LEADERS

## Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary

There are many methods for revitalizing our relationship with Jesus. One method that has proven to be effective for many is to the Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary.

In 1999 our family and other Catholic friends of ours consecrated ourselves to Jesus through Mary using the method outlined by St Louse de Montfort. It had many steps and prayers to be said every day during this time. It was a great spiritual exercise that benefitted me in so many ways. It was recommended that the consecration be repeated every year. I did not follow up the next year or the year after. I did not repeat my consecration until the Fall of 2013. This time I used a less vigorous method. Despite it being easier I found it to again be a wonderful experience of growing closer to Jesus through Mary. I was able to repeat my consecration again and look forward to again repeating it this fall!

Fr. Michael Gaitley's book *33 Days to Morning Glory* takes a look at four saints who can help us on our journey to Christ. In the book there is a schedule of when to start the preparation for consecration so that you can complete your consecration on a Marian feast day.

St Louis de Montfort;

Passion—to be set on fire for Christ.

Baptism—renewal of baptismal vows, through baptism we become Christ's.

Gift—give ourselves completely to Christ through Mary.

St Maximilian Kolbe;

Mystery—the opportunity to ponder the relationship between Mary and the Holy Spirit.

Militia—to build an army under Mary to give God the greatest glory.

Love—build a relationship with Mary much like the relationship we have with our earthly mothers of trust, relying on her intercession and speaking with her about all the things in our lives.

Blessed Mother Teresa;

Thirst—Mary wants us to share in the thirst for love and souls that Christ had while suffering on the cross for us.

Heart—the Immaculate Heart of Mary lend me your heart and keep me in your most pure heart.

Covenant—A pledge from the book, our duties and Mary's duties.

St John Paul II

Mother—the good news that we have a Mother in heaven who prayerfully and lovingly attends to our growth in Grace.

Entrust-ation—John and Mary at the foot of the cross, bring Mary into your home.

Mercy—the total consecration leads us to the Fountain of Mercy, Christ's pierced heart.
